## Collision Bend Brewing Company Announces Two New Holiday Beers

*Eight Crazy Nights Hanukkah Brew and Three Ships Christmas Stout debut Nov. 22*

**Cleveland** – Collision Bend Brewing Company announces two special holiday season beers available for a limited time. In celebration of Christmas and Hanukkah the brewery introduces Eight Crazy Nights Hanukkah Brew and Three Ships Christmas Stout November 22.

On Wednesday before Thanksgiving, Collision Bend will introduce two fresh concepts on holiday beers at the brewery to kick off the holiday season and will be available while supplies last.

Eight Crazy Nights Hanukkah Brew is an amber beer made with apples and honey combined with cinnamon and clove overtones. It's a medium-bodied beer with a spicy start and a not-too-sweet drier finish. At eight percent ABV, it's the perfect beer to toast while enjoying a Hanukkah dish at the brewery.

Three Ships Christmas Stout is not your typical holiday beer. Brewed with chocolate and orange, the toasted grain stout is a full-bodied beer with toasty-sweet flavor, but smooth finish due to utilizing a special Belgian yeast in the brewing process. The Christmas stout is six percent ABV.

“Clevelanders love their holiday beer and we wanted to offer something a little different than the traditional holiday brews out there. It's our take on celebrating Christmas and Hanukkah at the same time,” said Luke Purcell, brewmaster for Collision Bend Brewing Company. “We brewed these beers to be paired with specialty holiday food items. The chefs and I created these beers and culinary dishes to complement one another and feature seasonal flavors,” said Purcell.

Both beers will be available at Collision Bend Brewing Company starting the Wednesday before Thanksgiving at 3 p.m. with live music until 6 p.m., and served at Zack Bruell restaurants for a limited time.
